Thank you for your participation in the 2021 Box Elder County Fair Parade and for helping us to continue a wonderful tradition! Below is important information and instructions you will need for parade day. Please ensure that all participants have read and understood these instructions.

Please Note: All participants must enter on 1200 South (Rocket Road). Please DO NOT enter on Tremont Street.

Arrival:

We are asking that all parade entries (trucks, trailers, cars, etc.) be in place between 3:00 – 4:00. The riders on the floats and all horse entries need to be in place no later than 4:30. This will eliminate a lot of the problems that we have had in the past with people sitting for long periods of time that can be affected by the heat. If you are towards the back of the parade, feel free to extend that time for lineup so you don't have to sit in the hot sun for too long.

The person responsible for getting your entry down the parade route, (truck driver, advisor, team captain, etc.) needs to park, or be in your designated place and then check in with the person at your designated control area. *Please make sure that this person has magnets, tape, or whatever else you need to display your entry number.* Your entry number needs to be displayed on both sides of your entry, in a prominent place, making it easier to identify for the announcers. Your entry number will be provided to you via the email listed on the parade application.

NO HORSE TRAILERS will be allowed to park at their staging area. All trailers will have to be left at the South Stake Center parking lot on the west side or on the West side of 100 West at 600 North (Please be courteous in parking so that others may have adequate space also). This will avoid the confusion that we have run into with trying to get trailers out and to the fairgrounds while there are still people in their staging areas waiting to proceed down the route.

Line Up:

There will be <u>NO VEHICLES</u> allowed along Tremont Street to take riders to their staging area. Please make sure parents know this and allow adequate time for their children to be where they need to be in time.

The End:

After the end of the parade please turn east or west on 6th North. Doing so will ensure there is not back up and/or bottleneck before you unload. **Those entries turning west must go past 100 West; entries going east must go past 100 East before you may stop and unload.**

Due to the safety of all parade participants, please note that this year there will be no going from one entry to the other. Once your entry is done please exit the route along with all participants.

** THERE ARE ONLY TWO (2) VEHICLES PER ENTRY ALLOWED IN THE PARADE THIS YEAR. **

Please make sure that all parents know where to meet their children after the parade!
